

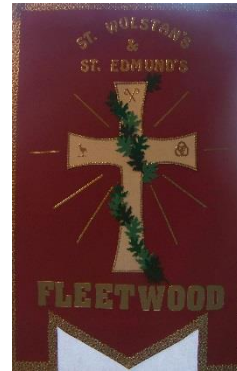
Bible Share: Will resume (after quite a long gap!) this Thursday 17th at 7pm in the presbytery after 6.30 Mass. All welcome.
