

Letter from Fr Andrew Broster: I have received a letter (not unfortunately an email which I could have put on here) written "To the people of St Wulstan's Parish". It is a huge thank you for the welcome and all the support you gave him when he was a Curate here in 2002. It's a very heartfelt message. (Wonder why it took 20 years to get here!) He has asked me to put it on the notice board for people to read, so you'll find it there.

PS from Brian Wood: On the 11th of March, 1791, the symphony number 96 by Josef Haydn was first performed in London. However, it became famous for a different reason. When the performance was completed, the audience rushed to the stage to applaud, as was the practice in those days. When the audience was applauding, a massive chandelier fell without warning and was smashed into pieces just where the audience had been sitting a few seconds earlier. In spite of there being thousands of shards of crystal there were no injuries to anyone, not even a single scratch. To this day Haydn's Symphony No 96 has borne the title of the Miracle Symphony. Dear Jesus, we thank you for all the music which lifts the spirits and calms the soul.
