CANDLEMAS: The Feast of Candlemas, or the Presentation of the Lord, is celebrated by Catholics on February 2, exactly 40 days after Christmas. It commemorates Mary's purification and the presentation of Jesus in the Temple, where Simeon hailed him as "Light to the Gentiles". The day is marked by blessing candles, which symbolize Christ's light, and it historically concludes the Christmas season. The feast highlights the encounter between the Holy Family and Simeon/Anna, focusing on obedience to Jewish law, the purification of Mary, and the light of Christ.

There will be two extra Masses in the parishes to celebrate this great Feast, 10am at St Marys and 6pm at St Wulstan's.
