<u>Bishop's Pastoral Letter</u>: Just a reminder from the last paragraph of Bishop Paul's pastoral.

On a practical note, by way of conclusion to this long letter, I would like to suggest four things. I would like first, each Catholic home to have a crib at the heart of their Christmas decorations. Secondly, I would like each of us to try and do something this Christmas to alleviate suffering and hardship in any form. Thirdly, I ask you to make Mass the main event of Christmas, even if it is 'inconvenient'. Finally, I ask you to pray for unborn children. They are the children of God, present in the world, just as Jesus was present in the womb of Mary for those nine months prior to his birth.



<u>Confirmation</u>: A big thank you to all who helped to make last Sunday's Confirmation ceremony such a wonderful occasion, not least our terrific candidates themselves. We pray that they will allow the Holy Spirit to lead and strengthen them in every step of their life's journey towards heaven. We also give thanks for Bishop Paul, who presided over our celebration with such joy.

Fleetwood Trust: As I mentioned last week, after over 3.5 years of trying, we have finally managed to buy Fleetwood Hospital from the NHS. This has been made possible by two large anonymous donations, and the creation of a Board of Trustees with various areas of expertise in finance, civil engineering, health services etc. There are ten of us on the Board, which will be chaired by Lord Tom McNally, an old boy from St Joseph's, Blackpool. The original vision of Tom Birch, (United Reform), Rev John Hall (St Peter's C of E) and myself (R.C.), was to give a United Christian witness to the gospel precepts of the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, which Our Lord urges on us, by creating a "one-stop" facility in the hospital, which would benefit the whole community, regardless of race, colour or creed. This is still at the heart of the vision, but some of our original ideas for the use of the floors have had to be modified to allow for an income stream to pay the running costs. On Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> there will be a public meeting in the hospital itself. People can visit anytime between 5pm to 8pm, entering by the North Albert St entrance. There will be a short presentation at 5.30pm and again at 7pm and people will be able to see the plans and ask any guestions. The building itself is guite a mess inside, and could be cold, so wear a warm coat if you're coming.
