Keeping Our Grounds Beautiful: A suggestion has come in from a parishioner, whom I know does a bit of this herself. It says "Maybe some people could/would be aware of odd jobs that need doing around the grounds e.g. emptying the grids of leaves - needs doing 6-8 times in the winter months, sweeping leaves. Access to the Church or presbytery is not necessary for such jobs".

Keeping the Green Hut Looking Good: A request has also come in from the church cleaning crew, for the Green Hut not to be used as a 'dumping ground' for stuff which sometimes makes it look like a junk shop, and is difficult to clean around properly.


