Wednesdays 2pm - meet at Wyre Estuary Country Park

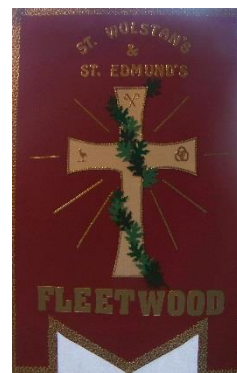

Going to The Edinburgh Festival? SPUC have written advertising a Pro-Life play called "Crowned with Glory and Honour" taking place on the Fringe from August 6th-10th. Based on true stories and interviews, this new play asks pivotal question with humour and directness. The story examines life and how we, as either cultures or individuals, determine which people are valuable and which are disposable.
