

Angela Cole's young daughter-in-law Libby has had to have a double mastectomy this week because of breast cancer. While this is a very sad thing to happen to one so young, Libby has decided to turn her own misfortune into helping other women in a very practical way. So, to Angela's note:-

'Against Breast Cancer' is a charity which collects and recycles unwanted bras, both new and used, and the money they receive for the bras goes to funding breast cancer research. The bras go to developing African countries where it's too expensive to produce them locally. This provides a source of income for small businesses, helping keep families out of poverty, while allowing women access to affordable bras. In these countries many women without underwear are seen to be in poverty, and therefore more likely to be targeted for rape. Bras can be brought to either of our churches and will be passed on to the charity by Angela Cole. Thank You.
