

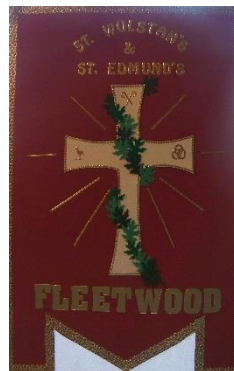

Bishop's Visitation 28-29 September: Next weekend we are delighted to welcome Bishop Paul to the parish for his official episcopal visitation. In the early days of the Church a bishop was known as "Episcopus" which literally means "Inspector". For when a bishop comes on visitation it is to 'inspect' how the parish is doing, as he is responsible before God, for the spiritual welfare of the People of God in his diocese. While here, the Bishop will inspect all the sacramental records and registers, as well as consult with the Parish Pastoral Council. He will celebrate Mass for us, preach and visit some of our sick and housebound. It's a fairly short visit, but we'll make him welcome.

Catholicism In Post Modern Society: The Christian Heritage Centre at Stonyhurst will be hosting a talk on Tuesday 1st October at 7.30pm by Michael Dopp, a well-known Canadian speaker, on the New Evangelisation, aimed at forming laity in their task of evangelising. This will be followed on 2nd October by an all-day conference on evangelisation, specifically aimed at both clergy and laity, offering fresh impetus and consideration of evangelising today. This will be an ideal day event particularly for those parishioners actively involved in some form of leadership or ministry, although all it is obviously open to all! Family Fast Day: Our next CAFOD FFD will be on Friday 4th October when we are invited to eat less that day and donate what money we save to relief of poverty in the Third World. CAFOD envelopes are provided at the back of church.

It's Not Just About Migrants: Sunday 29th September is the World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR). This year's theme is 'it is not just about migrants'. With this theme, Pope Francis wants to stimulate our prayer and action by reflecting on ways in which migrants, refugees, internally displaced persons and victims of human trafficking are part of a wider concern for all marginalised people.
