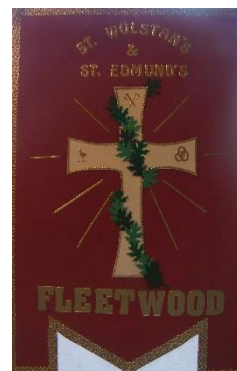


## Repeats
