THE EASTER TRIDUUM

The three-day feast, the Easter Triduum, is the central feast of the year for Christians. Everything we do in the other 51 weeks takes its meaning from these three days. These are days to be enjoyed, and certainly not to be missed. We all have commitments: work, family, entertainment and so on. But on these days we are asked, wherever humanly possible, to set aside all engagements and to plan ahead so that we can be free to participate fully in the life of the Church from the Thursday night to the Saturday vigil. Some people are able to make both Good Friday and Holy Saturday into days of fasting. Others began to prepare for the Vigil, where possible, by extra periods of prayer and reflection. It doesn't matter how we prepare, as long as we are ready. Whatever we do, we should not miss the three liturgies. We need to be enriched by God's word spoken through the Triduum, and our parishes need our presence so that the community may gather and form the body of Christ which is the Church. Each time we gather over these three days, we celebrate in Word and song, sign and ritual, the most beautiful and moving proclamation of God's never ceasing care for our world. Maundy Thursday: the Mass of the Lord's supper; Good Friday: the Solemn Liturgy of the Passion; Holy Saturday: the Vigil of the Resurrection. Mark them in your diary now. No matter what happens, don't miss the vigil! **Ernest Sands**
