It was pointed out to Fr Alf on Sunday that a number of people have not yet had any money taken from their bank account, even though they had handed in their forms.

What should have happened, and did in many cases, thankfully, was that only the Gift Aid forms should have been handed in to us.

The actual Standing Order can only be made to the bank by the Donor. However, if you can't do that on the Internet, we can supply a form which you can post to your bank.

Once you have made your Standing Order, we will be able to claim Gift Aid on your donation. For those who have been long-term donors to the Foodbank, and who haven't signed a Gift Aid form, but would like to, we can provide one. We can then claim Gift Aid going back over the last four years, which would be a tremendous boost for the Food bank in these testing times. Thank you.
